

Fear to return to your country

» Not able to live in peace in any part of your country


Fear of persecution based on:

- » Race
- » Nationality
- » Religion
- » Political Opinion
- » Membership in a Particular Social Group


Convention against Torture (CAT)

The role played by your country's government in the persecution and/or torture

CREDIBLE FEAR INTERVIEW (CFI)

The interview will happen by telephone

You will have a translator during the interview

If you do not understand a question, you can ask for clarification

During the interview:

- » Speak slowly and clearly
- » Respond with a lot of details
- » Do not assume that the immigration officer knows what is happening in your city or country
